# Why Implement Shared Services?



## The Imperative

- Embrace user-centered design
  - Bridge tech & business, empowering Portfolio Managers to execute at the lowest level
- Reduce duplicative and disparate activities through deliberate application of "enterprise first"

## Re-Imagining Service Delivery

- Deliver value-added, standard, efficient services to and "shared" <u>across</u> multiple Portfolio
   Managers or <u>among</u> Product Managers within a Portfolio
- Leverage scarce expertise and grow new skills
- Improve over time through organizational & operational shifts for us and our users

## Opportunities Gained

- Aggregation of resources and systems to improve the quality, timeliness, and cost effectiveness of service delivery to customers
- Build capacity for innovation and new work through shared services

# Shared Services Intersection with Portfolios / Products / CDTs



#### **Service Domain Owner**


- Defines the service implementation strategy for the Domain
- Ensures processes and resources within the Service Domain enable Service Owners
- Appoints Service Owners; allocates resources within the Domain

#### **Service Owner**

- Accountable for delivery of one or more services throughout the entire service lifecycle
- Designs and implements approved Services; defines measures for service delivery
- Appoints Service Delivery Managers

#### **Service Delivery Manager**

- Manages day-to-day <u>execution</u> of one or more services
- Gathers/reports measurements for services



- Three primary roles for each service domain
  - Correspond with Portfolio/Product Manager
  - Deliver enabling services to BES capability delivery teams

# What is AFPEO BES doing?



## Making it happen with Agile

- As of Summer 2021, 74 of 97 programs transitioned to agile s/w dev w/ 360 personnel newly trained on agile processes
- Since Winter 2021, 12 new CDTs added (50 to 62); 20% increase in 6 months
- 135 projects embracing CI/CD in alignment w/ DoD DevSecOps guidance
- From Oct 20 to Apr 21, Increased emphasis on regular code scanning ID'd 3992 sec vulnerabilities from 1.5 "code smells" covering 40M lines of code

## Get to CloudONE ASAP

- As of Summer 2021, 20 BES Systems fully migrated w/ 40 on track over next 24 months
- May 2021, BES awarded the Cloud Acceleration and Transformation Service Contract (HI CATS) IDIQ (\$89M ceiling) to assist programs w/ Cloud migration challenges
- June 2021, CloudONE awarded a contract for build out of an Oracle Cloud which will establish a 4th Cloud Service Provider to support Enterprise Resource Planning Common Services (ERP-CS) programs such as BES's MROi, AFIPPS and DEAMS.

## • IT Contractors are smart....BES and Gov't IT getting smarter via Digital U!

- DU is training platform built around industry leading content providers that provides the latest training content to support the DAF's digital transformation
- DU currently has 25K users (airmen/civs at all levels) w/ funding to grow to at least 45K
- Current Stats: 100K+ training hours, 40 Udacity grads, 100+ senior leaders with general understanding across 5 tech domains, 30 cloud engineering students with 2 AWS certification paths available. Apple, AT&T, AWS, Cloud Academy, Google, Hyper Giant, Mastercard, Mattermost, Open Badges, Pluralsight, Stack Overflow, Trek10

## Too many accomplishments but a few recent highlights

- DEAMS: 15 Jan 2021 Full Deployment approved; now supports 17K users at 170
   Installations and all AF MAJCOMs, USSF, and Unified Commands where AF is exec agent
- Robotic Processing Automation (RPAs): BES w/ reps from PEO C3I&N and Digital,
   AFPC and ACC judged Contest #2 (of 4 planned in FY21) in Mar 2021 with 9 Champions selected from 70 team submissions; citizen developers exponentially growing across the AF
- BESPIN: 11 Feb 2021, BESPIN is an officially accredited software factory with a Continuous Authority to Operate (CATO) and delegated approval for app deployments to CloudONE






