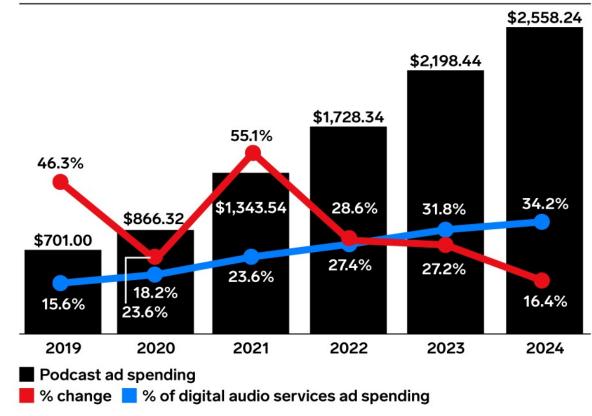
Podcast Advertising



US podcast ad spending will surpass **\$2 billion** in 2023.

Podcasts pull from numerous ad budgets

- Overall digital budgets were the most common funding source of podcast campaigns in 2021, per Advertiser Perceptions.
- About half of marketers used their digital audio budgets for podcasts.
- Most advertisers did not have dedicated podcast budgets.

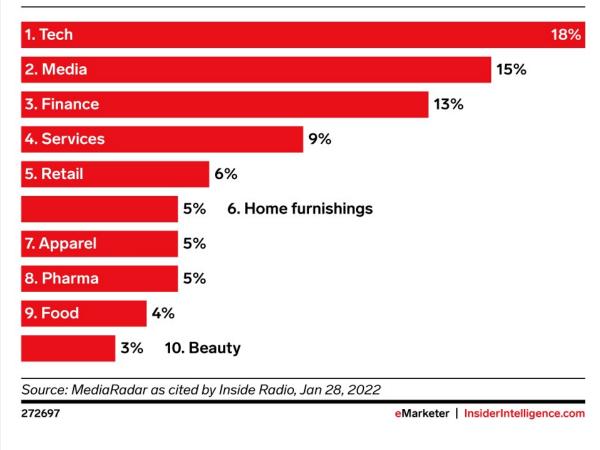

Podcast ad spend by industry

- Tech, media, and finance brands spent the most on podcast ads in 2021, per MediaRadar.
- Just over half of podcast ads were mid-rolls.
- In 2021, the number of brands running podcast ads grew 14%.

Top 10 Industries, Ranked by Share of US Podcast Ad Spending, 2021

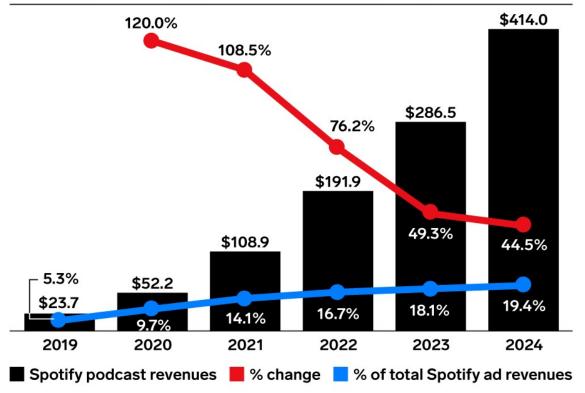

millions, % change, and % of total Spotify ad revenues



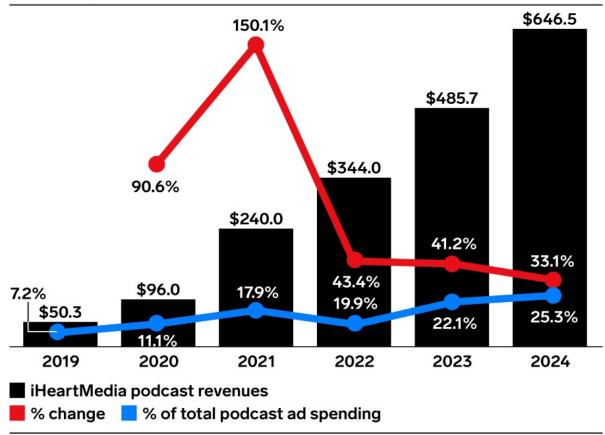

Podcast listenership doesn't have a 1:1 relationship to ad revenue

- Non-exclusive distribution is the norm.
- Podcasters sell inventory themselves and bake it into episodes.
- Subscriptions listening is common.
- This makes for an uneven relationship between listening and ad revenues.

BetterHelp was the top 2021 podcast advertiser, spending \$76.9 million, according to Magellan AI.

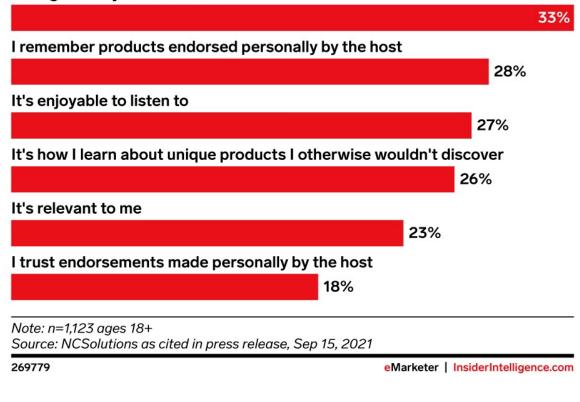

% of respondents

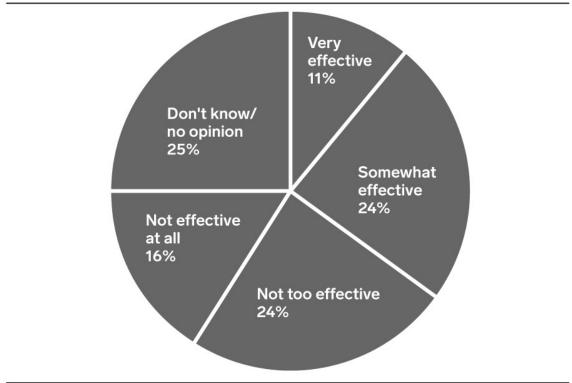
It's a good way for brands to reach me

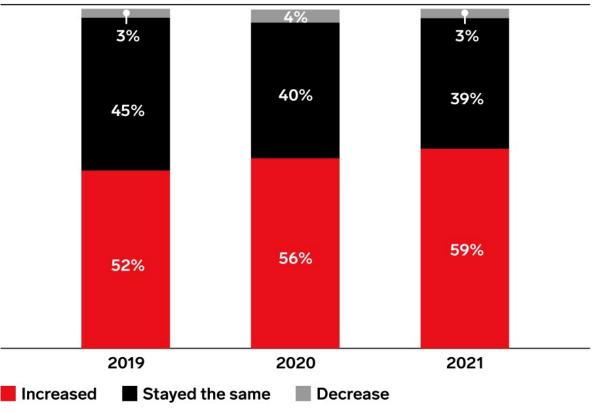

Do US Heavy* Podcast Listeners Feel That the Total Number of Ads in Podcasts Has Increased**?

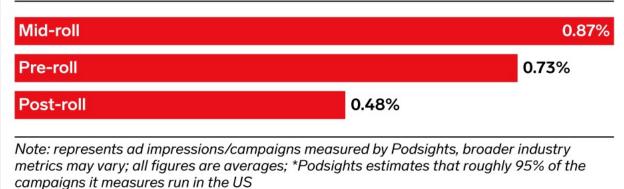

US* Podcast Ad Benchmarks: Average Conversion Rate, by Ad Format, Q4 2021

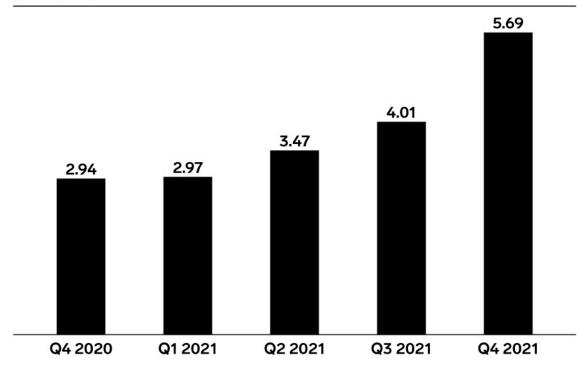

US* Podcast Ad Benchmarks: Average Ad Frequency, Q4 2021

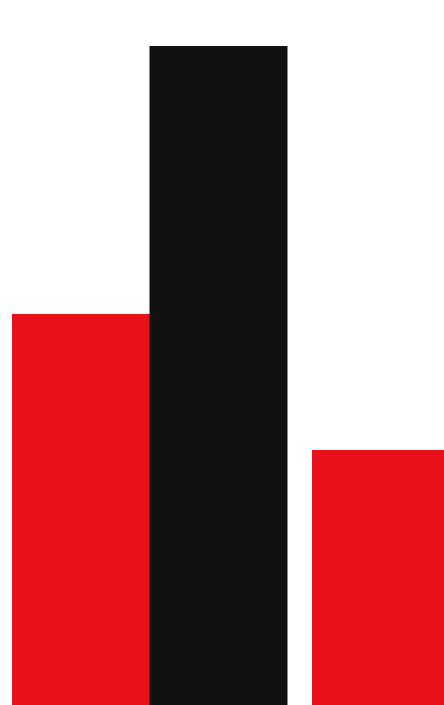

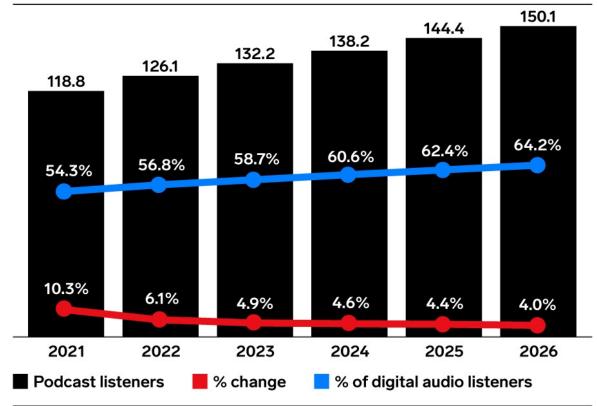
Podcast Listening

millions, % change, and % of digital audio listeners



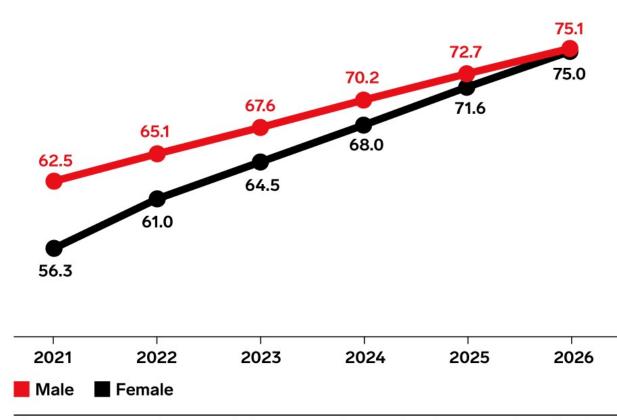

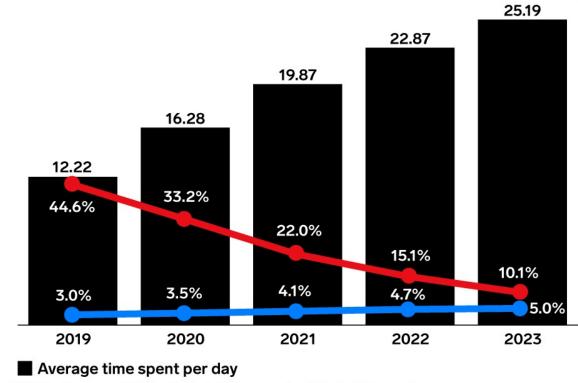

Time spent among the *general population* will grow 15.1% this year

- Podcasts account for about one-fourth of digital audio time spent.
- Time spent with podcasts is growing faster than listeners.
- This suggests casual podcast listeners increased their usage faster than the medium is able to add new users.

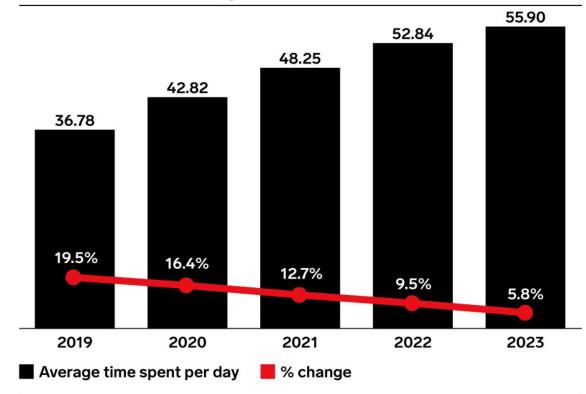

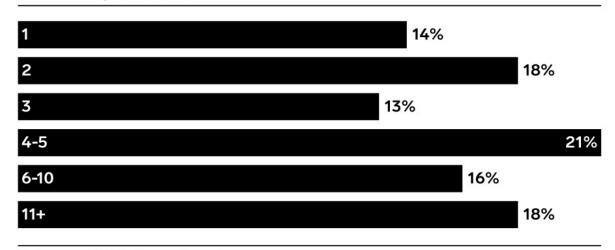

% of respondents



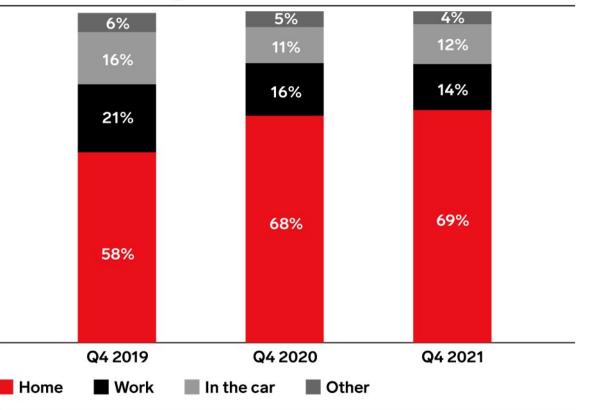

Share of Time Spent with Podcasts Among US Teens/Adults, by Location, Q4 2019-Q4 2021

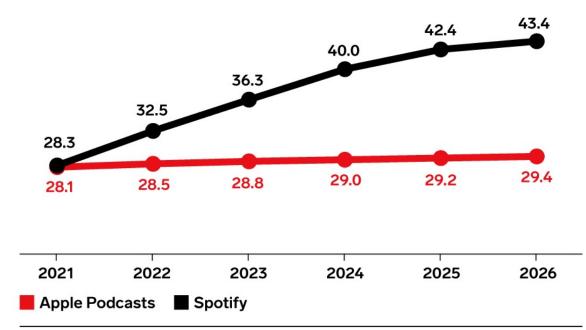

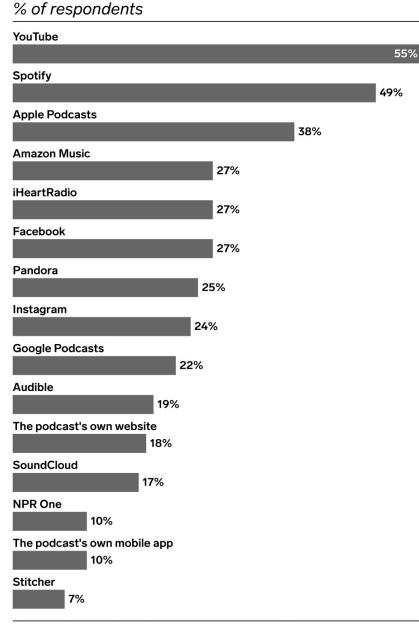

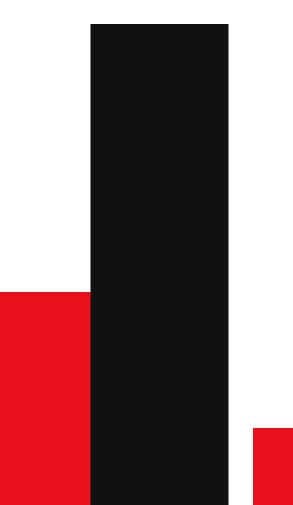
